Reciprocal Membership Agreement

Intent of reciprocation / mutual exchange is the relation or policy in dealings between Men's Sheds by which corresponding advantages or privileges are granted by each Shed to the members of the other.

Channel Men's Shed Inc. - Henley Mens Shed Inc.

This reciprocal membership agreement is intended to provide for the sharing of access, fellowship and benefit (singularly and collectively) to those who are members of the participating Sheds, as specified herein and between;

1. Upon proof of membership of one of the participating Sheds (either name tag or current membership card), a visiting member shall receive rights and privileges as if the person was a financial member of the visited Shed.
2. Visiting members shall pay any applicable user pays fees that may apply.
3. All visiting members must comply with the policies and rules of the host Shed.
4. Both Sheds shall include a reciprocal membership agreement statement on membership applications.
5. Participating Sheds shall communicate a schedule of upcoming events as an invitation to provide wider support and benefit.

This agreement shall remain in force until either of the parties gives notice of termination or a wish to renegotiate this reciprocal agreement.
