SHED MEMBERSHIP RULES

At the Henley mens Shed just as you would expect at all good clubs and organisations we need to establish a few ground rules, these rules are aimed to make this place a friendly and safe place for people to come to, and return as they wish.

To maintain membership of the Henley Mens Shed Inc. You agree to abide by the following;

- It is expected that members will to the best of their abilities maintain the property, buildings and equipment in good order,
- Members will act appropriately and maintain good standards,
- No non prescription drugs, or smoking will be permitted in or around the Mens Shed,
- Animals are not permitted in the Shed,
- Social gatherings involving alcohol will not be permitted during Shed (workshop) opening hours,
- Shed facilities are not to be used for personal monetary gain,
- No unauthorised, deliberate or irresponsible actions or misuse of Shed property will be permitted. Nor will actions that bring the Shed or its members into disrepute,
- Permission must be gained from the Shed Coordinator prior to displaying posters, notices, etc. in the Shed,
- Deliberate acts or failure to observe safety or hygiene standards, working in an unsafe manner, failing to make proper use of fire protection or safety equipment, will not be tolerated,
- All matters affecting the health, safety and welfare of members and visitors must be reported to the Coordinator or a Supervisor,
- Rules may be ammended or added to from time to time to reflect changes required by legislation, or the membership as a whole.
